The receipt of the treasurer or other proper officer of the said charity shall be sufficient discharge to my executors in the payment of this legacy. If at the date of my death, the said charity has ceased to exist or has amalgamated or become incorporated with another charity or has changed its name, then this legacy shall not fail, but my executors shall pay the legacy to such charitable organisations as they consider most nearly fulfils the objects of that which I intend to benefit.”
